The administrator of your personal data is Ipsos sp. z o.o. located in Warsaw at Domaniewska Street 34A, 02-672 Warsaw Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of:

- undertaking actions aimed at concluding a contract art. 6 sec. 1 letter b) GDPR
- implementation of cooperation art. 6 sec. 1

letter b) GDPR,

- communication with contact persons in the scope of implementation of cooperation - art. 6 sec. 1 letter f) GDPR (legitimate interest)
- providing a response to an inquiry art. 6 sec. 1 letter f) GDPR (legitimate interest),
- conducting the recruitment process art. 6 sec. 1 letter a) GDPR (consent); art. 6 sec. 1 letter c) GDPR (legal obligation)

Personal data is stored:

- for the period of cooperation,
- for the period necessary to provide a response to the inquiry, and after these periods for the time of prescription of any claims.
- until the completion of the recruitment process, unless the candidate has consented to participate in future recruitments.
- until an effective objection against further processing of data



In the case of implementation of cooperation, providing data is necessary for its implementation. Failure to provide this data will prevent the implementation of cooperation. In other cases, providing data is voluntary, but necessary to achieve the goals indicated above.

The recipients of personal data will be entities acting on behalf of the data administrator, i.e., entities providing IT services in terms of servicing and troubleshooting, entities belonging to the IPSOS group, as well as entities authorized to receive data based on legal provisions.



In connection with the processing of personal data, you have the following rights: the right to access the content of the data, the right to rectify the data, the right to delete the data, the right to restrict data processing, the right to object, the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.
