Affluent Generational differences in Civic Engagement

Patriotism can be expressed in various ways beyond traditional voting. Older generations tend to vote more often and engage more in traditional political activities as they index higher than Total Affluents. However, younger generations show lower indexes for voting but are more inclined to demonstrate their civic engagement through activism and protests.






(Affluent Generations Indexed to Total Affluents)
