

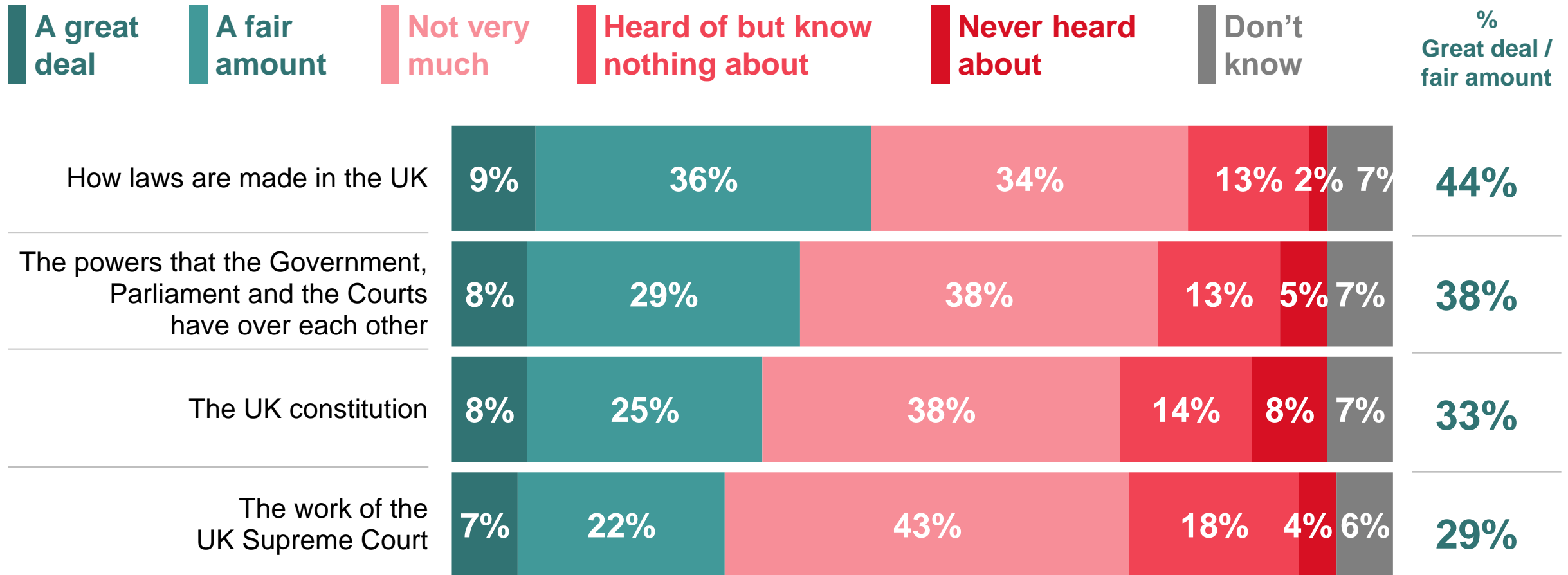

How much, if anything, do you feel that you know about each of the following?



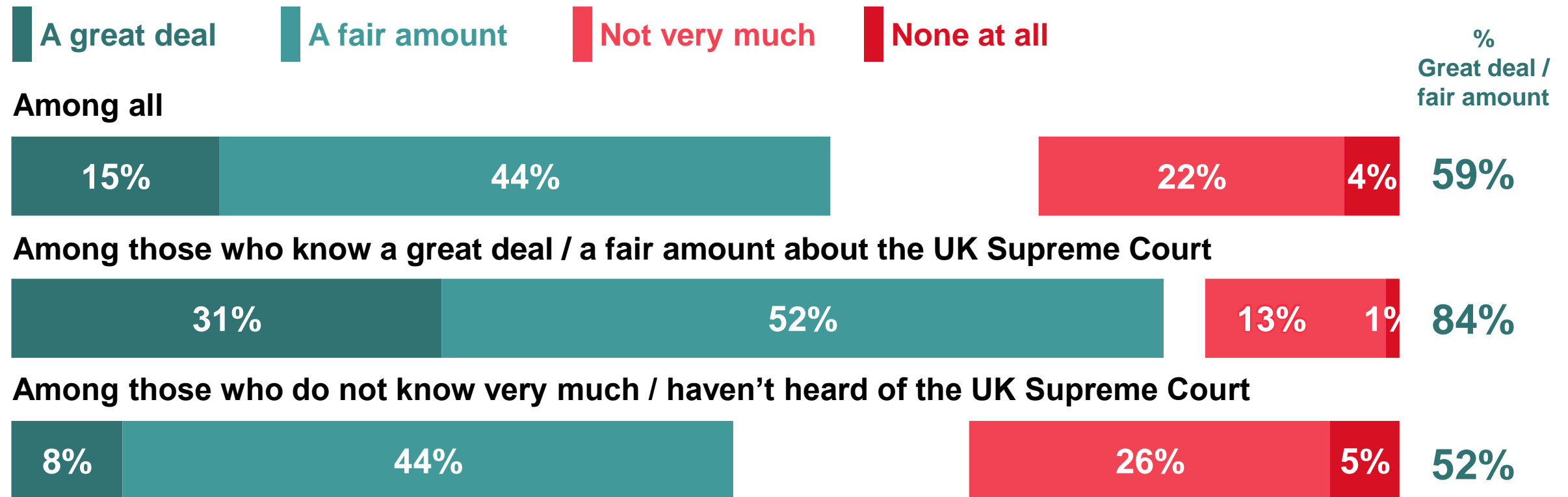

How much confidence, if any, do you have in the UK Supreme Court to do its job well?

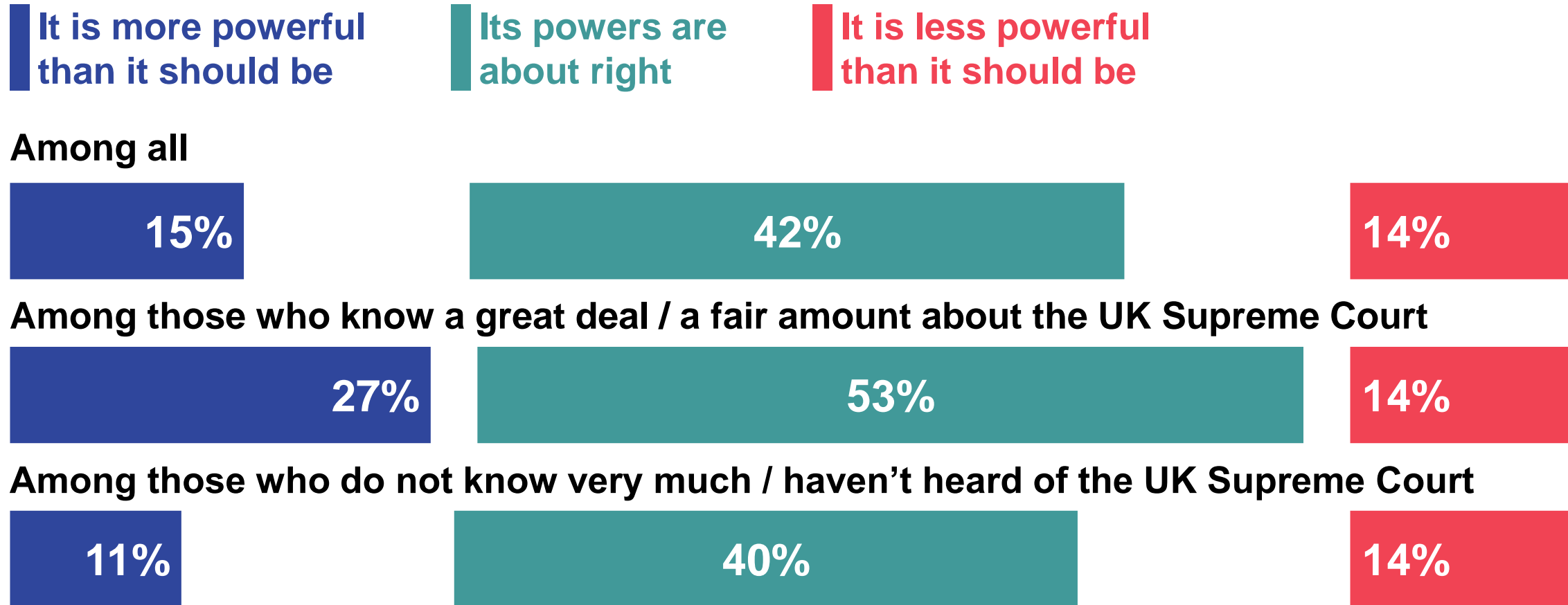

Too much **About right** **Too little**

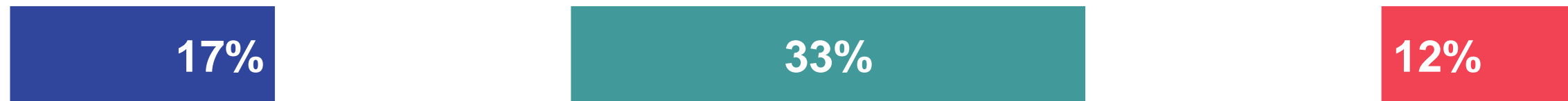

Among those who do not know very much / haven't heard of the UK Supreme Court

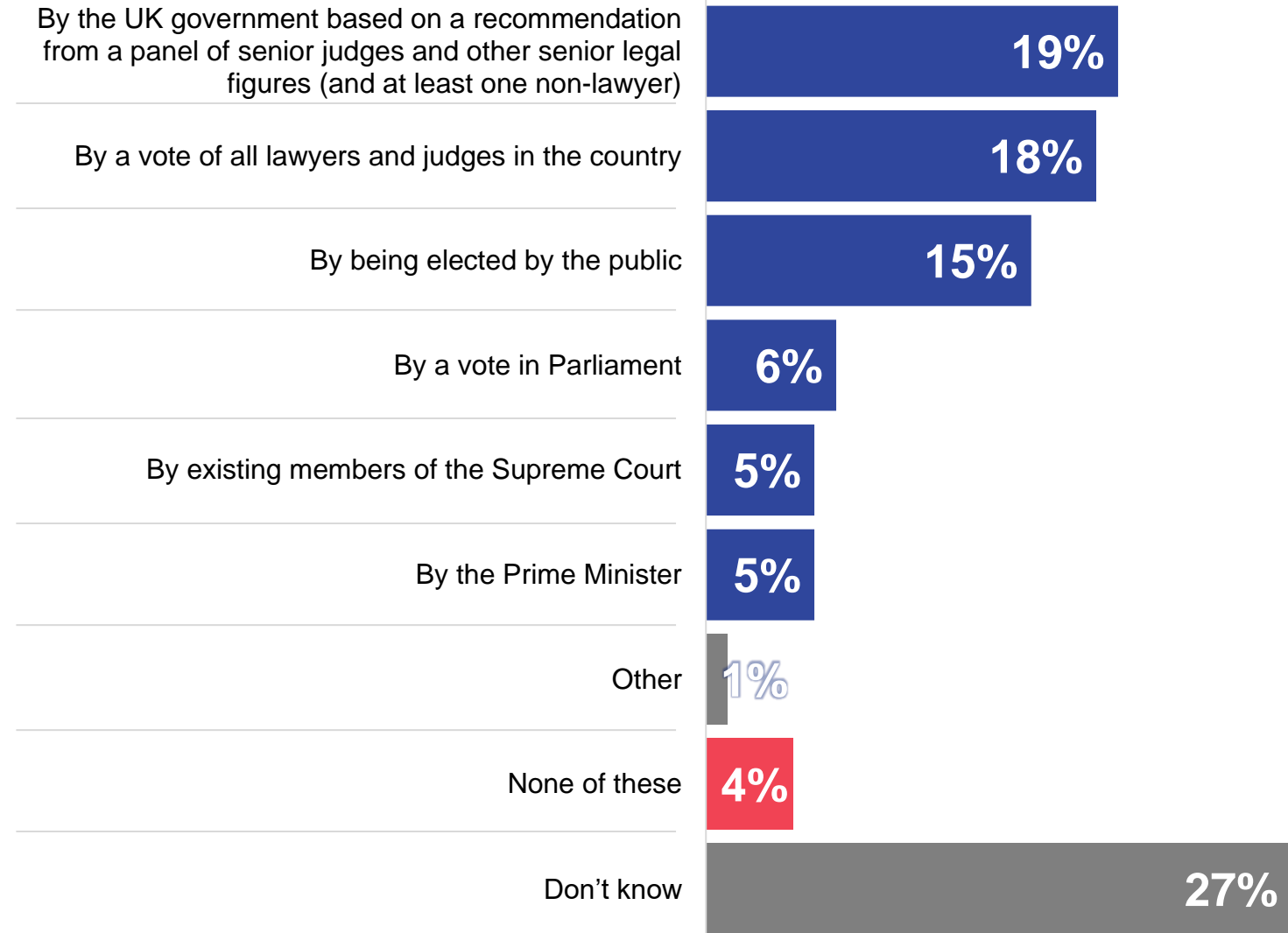
