




Many of the public continue to be concerned about the impact of the war on the UK economy and Ukrainian civilians






A large majority of the public continue to think President Zelenskyy has done a good job handling the Russian invasion of Ukraine

Good job Neither Bad job Don't know












Joe Biden: Handling of the Russian invasion of Ukraine







Volodymyr Zelenskyy: Handling of the Russian invasion of Ukraine







The European Union: Handling of the Russian invasion of Ukraine






Half think the UK Govt has provided the right amount of support to Ukraine

Base: 1,000 Online British Adults 18-75, 21-22 February 2023 Including Conservative voters (324) and 2019 Labour voters (242)




Support remains high for a range of measures to offer Ukraine assistance during the war


3 in 5 feel that economic sanctions on Russia are necessary, even if it means energy and food price will remain high
