

### 9 in 10 parents buy their child(ren) gifts for Christmas


Do you buy gifts for your child/children for Christmas, or no?

Have you ever told your child/children that Father Christmas has gotten at least some of their gifts for them?






# 3 in 5 parents are concerned about their ability to afford Christmas presents this year
