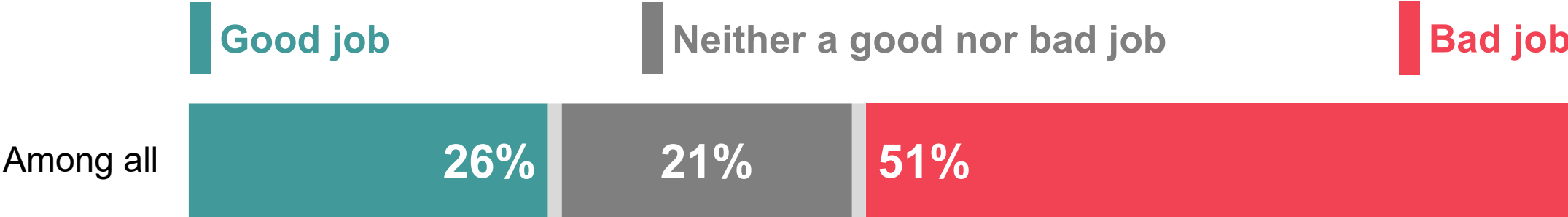

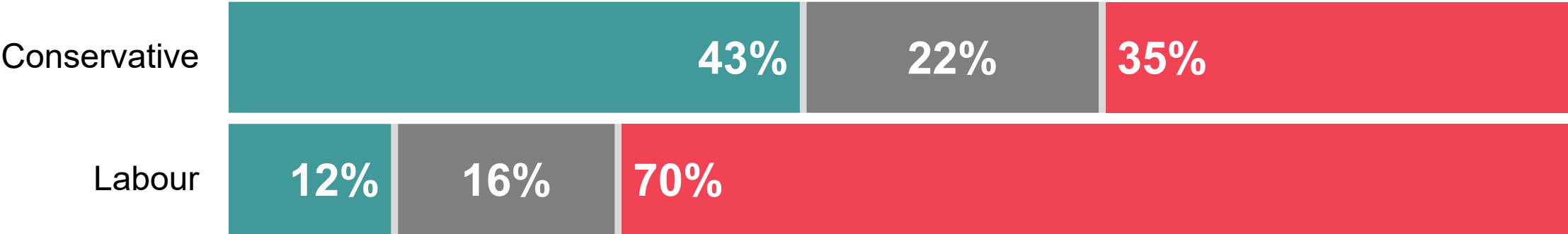

Overall, do you think the UK government did a good or bad job at handling the Covid-19 pandemic?



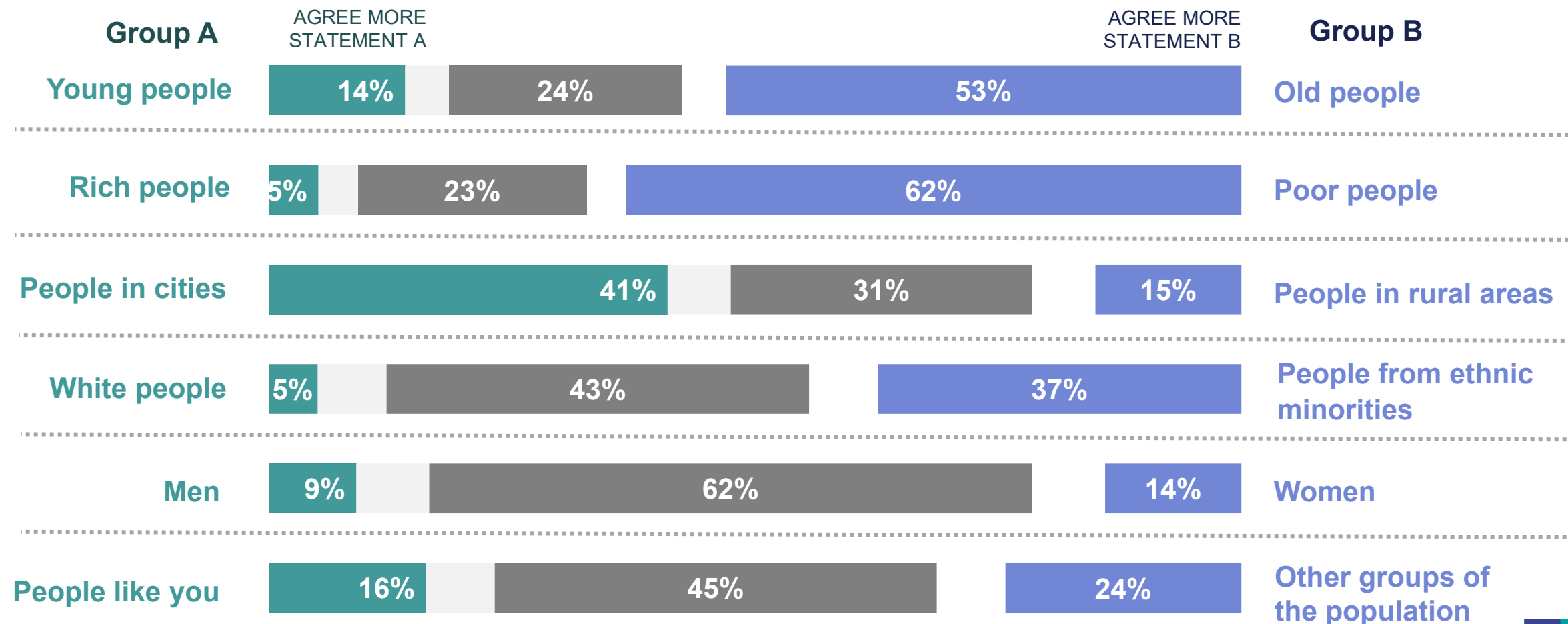
## By 2019 General Election vote

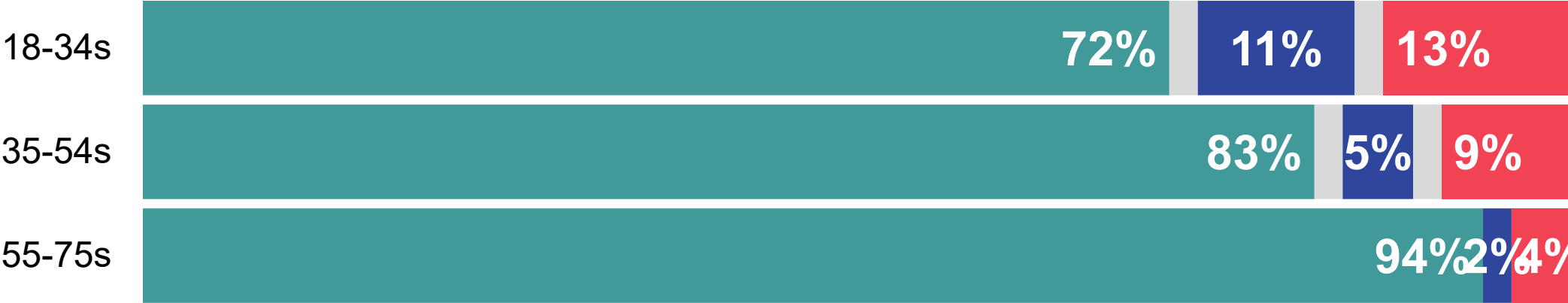


# Over 4 in 5 said they personally followed the Government's rules on COVID-19 at least most of the time

## By age

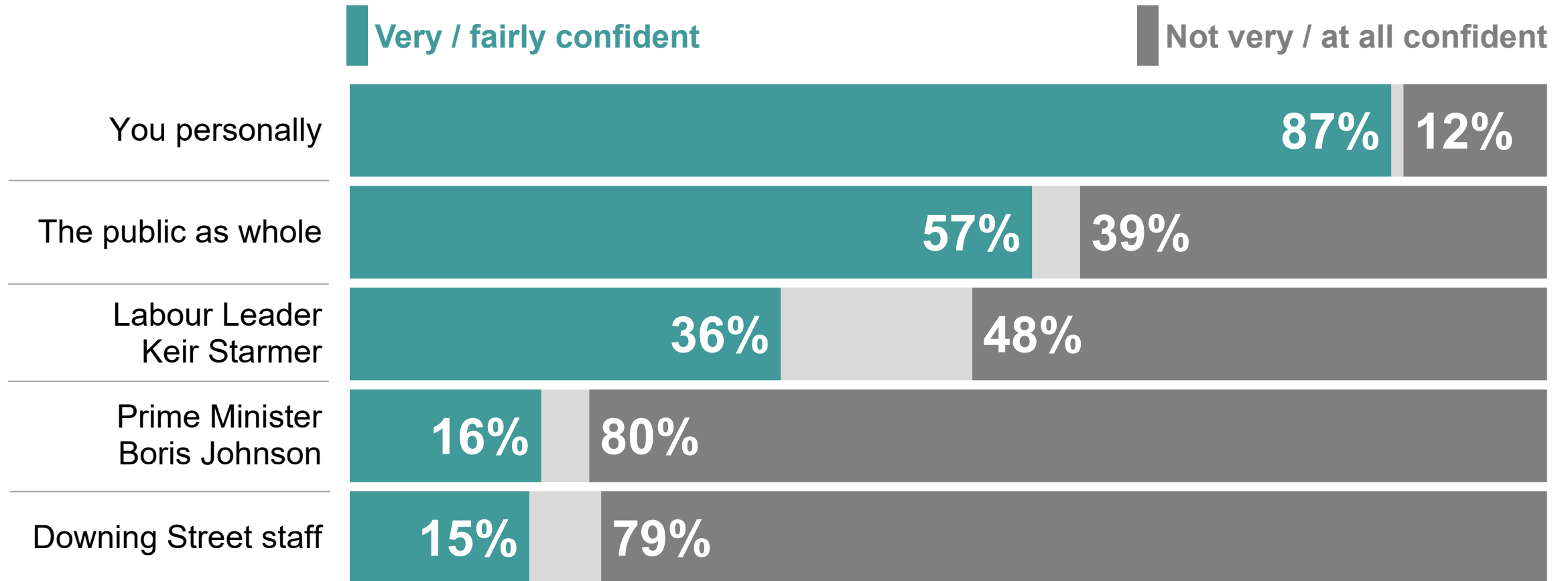
