


Half continue to think Sunak is doing a bad job as Prime Minister



The majority do not trust either the Conservatives or Labour on immigration issues


To what extent, if at all, do you trust each of the following political parties to...?




Trust among Conservative supporters for their party to have the right policies towards immigration continues to decline










