



Voting Intention: June 2024

How do you intend to vote in the General Election? Will you vote...?








Base: 1,402 British adults 18+,21-25 June 2024; Headline Voting Intention: all 9/10 certain to vote, always/usually/it depends vote in General Election who gave a voting intention = 794. 85% of these likely voters gave a voting intention. Margin of error is displayed at +/- 4% All polls are subject to a wide range of potential sources of error. On the basis of the historical record of the polls at recent general elections, there is a 9 in 10 chance that the true value of a party's support lies within 4 points of the estimates provided by this poll, and a 2 in 3 chance that they lie within 2 points. This is especially important to keep in mind when calculating party lead figures.

How would you vote if there were an election tomorrow?




How would you vote if there were an election tomorrow?




Who might you vote for instead?

If you do change your mind about voting for this party, which party would you vote for instead?


Among all who might change their mind












Satisfaction with leaders and the Government: June 2024











Number of months after becoming prime minister






Are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the way Keir Starmer is doing his job as leader of the Labour Party?












Economic Optimism Index

Do you think that the general economic condition of the country will improve, stay the same or get worse over the next 12 months?







Do you think that the general economic condition of the country will improve, stay the same or get worse over the next 12 months?





Who do you think would make the most capable Prime Minister, the Conservative's Rishi Sunak, or Labour's Keir Starmer?







Which of these statements come closest to your views of ... and the ... party?



Which of these statements come closest to your views of ... and the ... party?



Which of these statements come closest to your views of ... and the Labour party?





Thinking about the outcome of the next General Election, which of the following, if any, comes closest to your view?








Is Labour ready to form the next **Government?**








Which party do you think has the best policies on managing the economy, the Conservatives, Labour, Liberal Democrats or some other party?





Best party on taxation: 1979-2024





Which party do you think has the best policies on asylum and immigration, the Conservatives, Labour, Liberal Democrats or some other party?












Best party on housing: 1978-2024

Which party do you think has the best policies on housing, the Conservatives, Labour, Liberal Democrats or some other party? (Note before 1988 this was asked as "NHS")




Which party do you think has the best policies on education, the Conservatives, Labour, Liberal Democrats or some other party?

Which party do you think has the best policies on crime and anti-social behaviour, the Conservatives, Labour, Liberal Democrats or some other party?





Which party do you think has the best policies on the environment, the Conservatives, Labour, Liberal Democrats or some other party?



Which party do you think has the best policies on pensions, the Conservatives, Labour, Liberal Democrats or some other party?





Best party on reducing the cost of living: 2022-2024


Which party do you think has the best policies on reducing the cost of living, the Conservatives, Labour, Liberal Democrats or some other party?





Best party on poverty and inequality: 2015-2024


Which party do you think has the best policies on poverty and inequality, the Conservatives, Labour, Liberal Democrats or some other party?
