

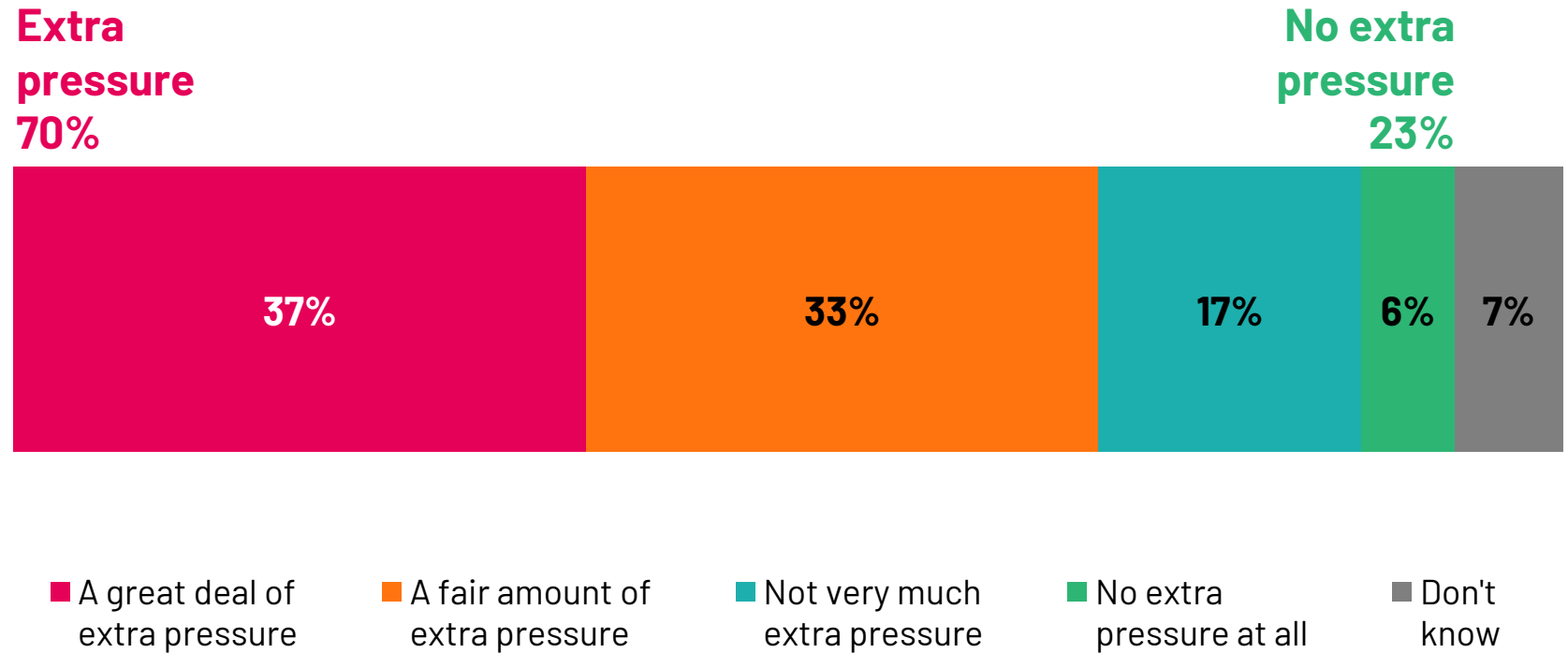

Q. How much extra pressure, if any, do you think is put on the NHS by immigrants to the UK using NHS services?

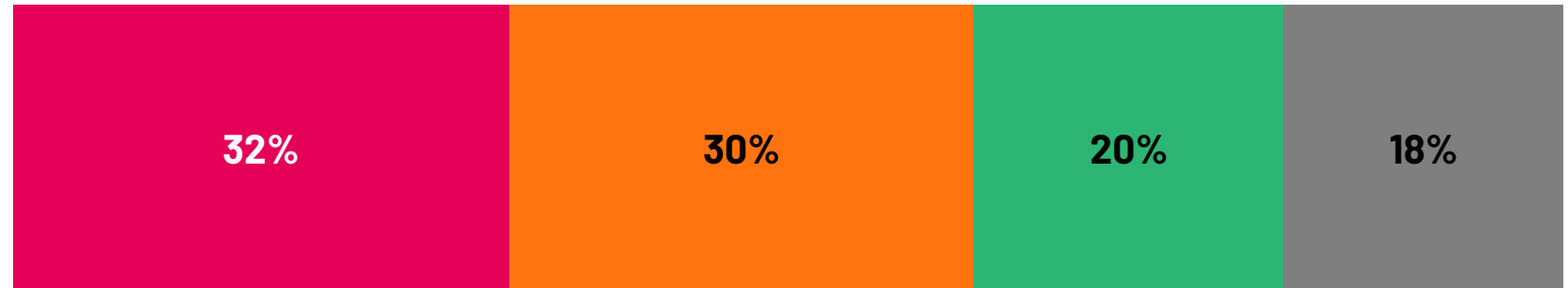

■ Don't know

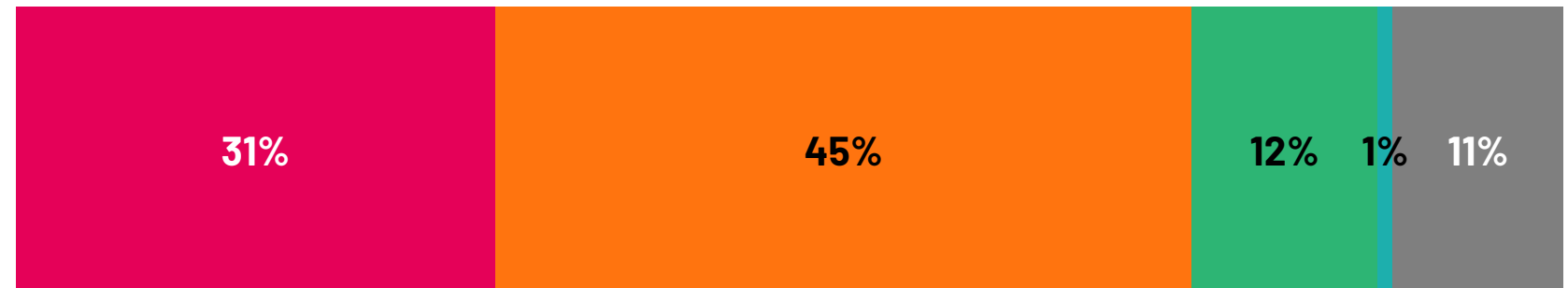
Extent to which the NHS relies on migrant workers

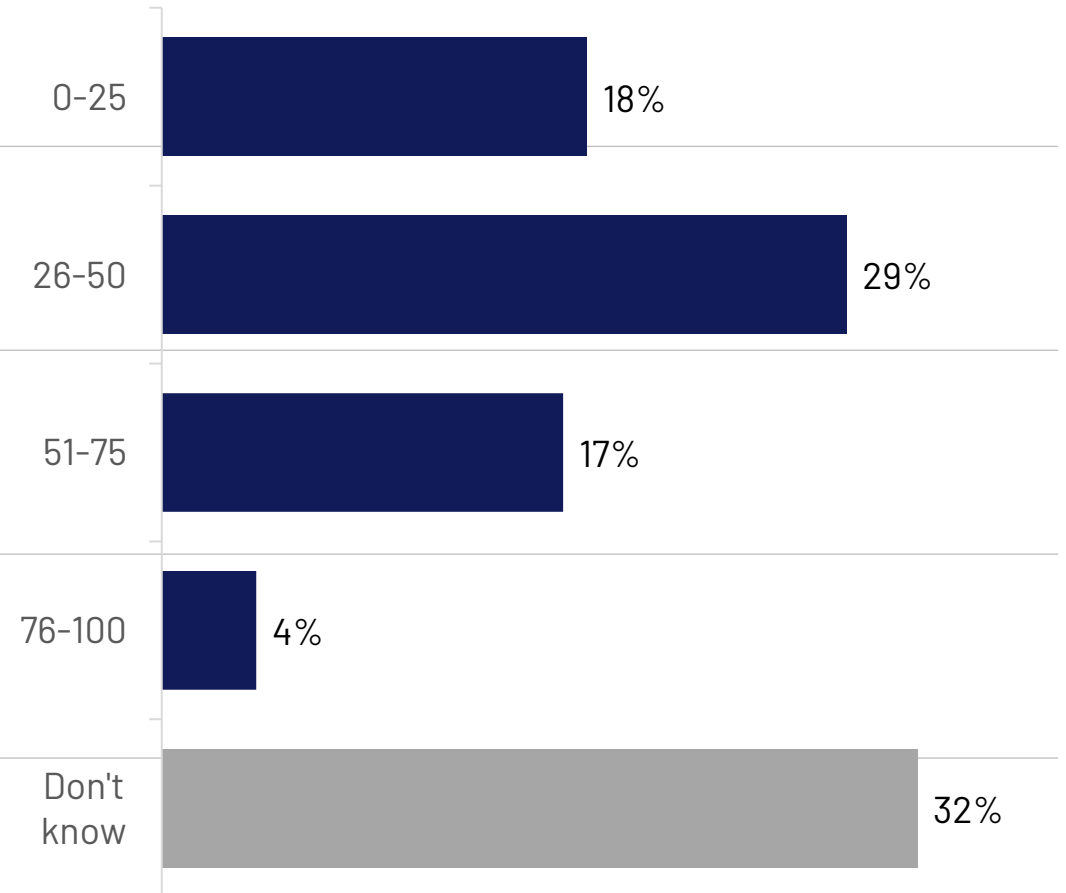
Proportion of NHS workers who are migrants
