


Voting Intention: Ipsos' 2024 General Election Final Poll

How do you intend to vote in the General Election? Will you vote...?






Base: 2,076 British adults 18+, 1-3 July 2024; Headline Voting Intention: all 9/10 certain to vote, always/usually/it depends vote in General Election who gave a voting intention = **1217**. Margin of error is displayed at +/- 4% All polls are subject to a wide range of potential sources of error. On the basis of the historical record of the polls at recent general elections, there is a 9 in 10 chance that the true value of a party's support lies within 4 points of the estimates provided by this poll, and a 2 in 3 chance that they lie within 2 points. This is especially important to keep in mind when calculating party lead figures.

How would you vote if there were an election tomorrow?





How would you vote if there were an election tomorrow?






Only two in five 2019 Conservatives are currently saying they still support the party this election

Among all 2019 Conservatives






Who might you vote for instead?

If you do change your mind about voting for this party, which party would you vote for instead?


Among all who might change their mind

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




What's deciding your vote?

The party you support has little chance of winning in this constituency so you vote for the [party] to try and keep another party out














