


## 85% of people think that British society is divided, a small rise and the highest since 2019.

Overall, how divided do you think British society is these days? Long term trend



To what extent, if at all, are you concerned about each of the following?










Three quarters of those who think crime has gone up in the UK as a whole, think that because of things they've seen on the news

Which of the following statements comes closest to your opinion about the range of political views in Britain?





Now thinking about the people in the UK with **opposing** political views to you. To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following?



To what extent, if at all, do you think the below statement provides an accurate or inaccurate description of Britain today? "In Britain today, mob rule is replacing democratic rule."






## Following the recent riots and unrest across the UK, a large majority are concerned about the safety of people living in communities where riots and unrest has taken place

Concerned Not Concerned


