
### Half of Britons continue to think that if Donald Trump is elected President, it would have a negative impact on the UK's relationship with the US

Do you think the following outcomes of the US presidential election would have a positive or negative impact on the UK's relationship with the US, or would they make no difference?





And who would you prefer to win the US Presidential election in November?





And who would you prefer to win the US Presidential election in November?






And who would you prefer to win the US Presidential election in November?







Almost half of Britons say they personally care about who wins the US election – slightly higher than those that say they don't care



## Two in five think Kamala Harris would do a good job as Prime Minister of the UK – three in five think Donald Trump would do a bad job


Do you think ... would do a good job or a bad job, if either, if they were Prime Minister of the UK?
