This Ipsos poll was conducted January 20-21, 2025, on behalf of Reuters using the KnowledgePanel®. This poll is based on a representative sample of 1,077 U.S. residents, age 18 or older.

The study was conducted in English. The margin of error takes into account the design effect, which was 1.4 for all adults. our reporting of the findings, percentage points are rounded off to the nearest whole number. As a result, percentages in a given table column may total slightly higher or lower than 100%. In questions that permit multiple responses, columns may total substantially more than 100%, depending on the number of different responses offered by each respondent.
